The Garden Gathering

Lesson #4

Age: 2nd Grade



Objective:

- Students will make a plan for writing that includes a central idea.
- Students will write to communicate ideas effectively.
- Students will use personal perspective in responding to a work of literature to increase comprehension of THEME.

Materials:

The Garden Gathering by Julie Woik Pencils or Pens Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson. See attached *Letter for Parents*

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Garden Gathering. After reading the book, hand out the form that correlates with this lesson. Ask the students the following questions:

- 3. What helped Arnie to feel better?
- 4. What helped Sunny to feel better?
- 5. Do you think Lilly is right about wanting everyone to feel good about themselves?
