Age: 3rd Grade



Objective:

- Students will prepare for writing by identifying purpose and focusing on a central idea and supporting ideas.
- Students will write to communicate ideas effectively, using correct punctuation, capitalization and spelling.
- Students will recognize features of character and plot development.

Materials:

Activity:
