Lesson #4

Age: 5th Grade



Objective:

- Students will prepare for writing by identifying terms and focusing on a central idea.
- Students will write to communicate ideas effectively.
- Students will practice correct use of spelling, punctuation and capitalization.
- Students will use personal perspective in responding to a work of literature to increase comprehension of THEME.

Materials:

The Garden Gathering by Julie Woik Pencils or Pens Optional – Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson. See attached *Letter for Parents*

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Garden Gathering. After the reading, hand out the form that correlates to this lesson. Have the students find the correct answers, and write what they think. Have a discussion with the class afterwards.
