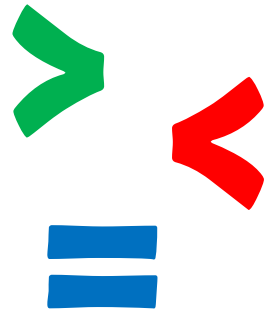


Art With Heart

Lesson #1



Age:
2nd Grade

Objective:

- Students will use number patterns and the relationships among counting and place value strategies to demonstrate an understanding of the whole number system.
- Students will understand the different ways numbers are represented in the real world.

Materials:

Art With Heart by Julie Woik

Pencils

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Art With Heart, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form for this activity. Discuss the importance of learning about whole numbers, and let the students know that all of the characters in the book would most likely know about numbers and measurements as well, as many art forms use mathematical equations to create a project.

Assessment:

Students will use the appropriate method of operation to solve specific problems and demonstrate an understanding of the value placed on a whole number.
