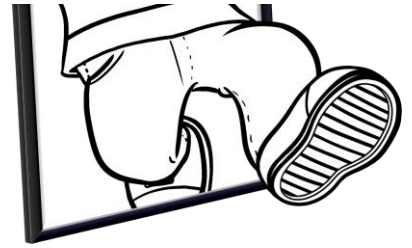


# Art With Heart

## Lesson #4



**Age:**  
2<sup>nd</sup> Grade

### Objective:

- Students will construct meaning from the illustrations.
- Students will use their personal perspective in responding to a work of literature, such as relating to a character or a simple event in the story.

### Materials:

Art With Heart by Julie Woik

Pencils

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

### Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Art With Heart, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form for this activity. Talk with the students about the creations Pibble made, and encourage them to create their own black and white pencil drawings. They should imagine that they are a pencil, and draw what they feel comfortable with. You can display the drawings in the room afterwards.

### Assessment:

Students will use their personal perspective to express an idea through illustration.
