Age:
3rd Grade

Objective:

- Students will use context clues, self-questioning, and visual cues, to construct meaning from the text and illustrations.
- Students will read the text to determine the main idea or the author's essential message.

Materials:

Art With Heart by Julie Woik

Pencils

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Art With Heart, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form for this activity. Express to the students the importance of understanding what happened on this page. This is a turning point for Pibble. Then ask the students to use their own words to create a narrative for this event in the book.

Assessment:

Students will identify the author's purpose in the text by rereading, summarizing, and engaging in a class discussion if necessary. They will then write a narrative to communicate their thoughts and ideas regarding this change in Pibble's life.
