Age:
4th Grade

Objective:

- Students will understand the meaning of cause and effect.
- Students will recognize that one event is the result of another.
- Students will be able to identify the difference between cause and effect.

Materials:

Art With Heart by Julie Woik

Pencils or Pens

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Art With Heart, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form for this activity. Review “cause and effect” with your students, providing real scenarios that they can easily relate to.

Example of a Cause: “You push someone down.”

Example of an Effect: “You go to the Principal’s office.”

Assessment:

Students will recognize the meaning and the reason for cause and effect in a piece of literature. They’ll understand how this combination of action and reaction move the story forward.

Reviewing the cause and effect helps children recall the events in the story.
