Objective:

- Students will be able to identify the basic elements of art.
- Students will provide a critique of the illustrated work.
- Students will have an enhanced understanding of art and observational skills.

Materials:

Art With Heart by Julie Woik

Pencils or Pens

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Art With Heart, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form for this activity. Provide a good amount of time for all of the students to study the illustrations in the book. Once they've had an opportunity to really check out the pages, have them critique the artwork. This activity will allow the students to offer their opinion, and discuss with others their feelings and ideas about art as a whole.

Assessment:

Students will recognize the various elements that shape a particular piece of art or an artist's style. They'll offer their opinion regarding that artwork. Their observational skills will help them develop an appreciation for various art forms.
