

# Similar...but Different

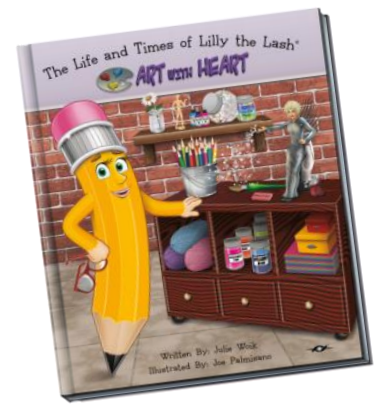
All of the storybooks in The Life and Times of Lilly the Lash series follows a particular pattern, yet are different in many ways.

6. Who did the author go back in time and talk about in each of the books?

7. What is the name of the plan that Lilly the Lash makes in each of the books?

8. On what surface did Lilly the Lash make her plan in each of the books?

9. Which character did Lilly the Lash bring into each of the stories to help teach the lesson?

10. What same sparkling magical occurrence takes place in each of the books?

11. How did the character with the problem make things right in each of the books?

12. On the last page, Lilly's about to head out. Where is she located, and what is she doing?
