Lesson #5



Age:
5th Grade

Objective:

- Students will write to communicate information.
- Students will write about a personal experience relating to the lesson in the story.

Materials:

Art With Heart by Julie Woik

Pencils

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Art With Heart, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form for this activity. Have a discussion about the book and the lesson it teaches. Give the students an opportunity to talk about the importance of having confidence, how easily it can be lost, and how it feels to get it back again. Then have them detail how they helped someone gain back their confidence. If they don't have an experience to draw on, have them think of ways that could help someone if they had the chance.

Assessment:

Students will recognize the importance of the lesson being taught in the story, and will communicate through their writing, how they were able to help someone gain back their confidence.
