### Objective:

- Students will recognize and understand the different ways numbers are represented.
- Students will measure quantities.
- Students will use comparison for problem solving.

### Materials:

Art With Heart by Julie Woik

Pencils or Color Pencils

### Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Art With Heart, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form in which students will compare various images from the book, and then determine the correct count for each unit. Happy Hunting!!

### Assessment:

Students will see how objects can be used to represent whole numbers, and will learn to use indirect comparisons to determine the quantities of those objects.
