Art With Heart Lesson #2

Behavioral Issue:

Indicates that he/she does not care about performance, grades, or consequences of behavior

Objective:

- Student will demonstrate concern regarding their performance.
- Student will exhibit consideration of consequences surrounding their behavior.

Materials:

Art With Heart by Julie Woik Form for this Activity Pen or Pencil

Activity:

Read the Art With Heart book to the student/students participating in this activity. Discuss the lesson taught in this book, which is confidence. Hand out the activity. Explain that this is completely their thoughts and ideas. Talk about how confidence can make a difference in motivating one's self, or how the lack of it can lead you to not care about the outcome of life. Try to determine what could inspire the students to become excited about learning and motivated to display healthy and appropriate behavior.

Assessment:

Students will reveal issues they may have with learning or difficulties they're experiencing in the classroom. This open and honest conversation may help everyone see and understand why certain struggles are occurring.
