The Garden Gathering

Lesson #1

Age: 1st Grade



- Students will read for information to use in performing a task.
- Students will use knowledge of both text and illustrations to identify differences between characters.
- Students will use personal perspective in responding to a work of literature, by identifying differences between themselves and others.

Materials:

The Garden Gathering by Julie Woik Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson. See attached *Letter for Parents*

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Garden Gathering, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form showing the different characters. Ask the students to write differences from one character to another, and how they are different from others.

Assessment:

Students use their knowledge of text and illustrations to identify differences between characters, by writing them out.
