The Garden Gathering Lesson #5

Age: 4th Grade



Objective:

- Students will construct meaning from the text.
- Students will respond critically to a work of literature.

Materials:

The Garden Gathering by Julie Woik Index/Flash Cards and a photograph of child (bring from home) Pens/Markers/Colored Pencils and Glue Magazines and other decorations are optional Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson. See attached Letter for Parents

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Garden Gathering. After the reading, briefly review the story theme regarding everyone's differences and values. Then make the cards.

- 1. Students paste their picture on card (they can decorate if they like).
- 2. On the back, they'll write a personal strength, talent, or interest and an intended goal related to that subject.
- 3. The teacher will collect the cards and place them into a box.
- 4. One card a day (or as many as you wish) is picked out of the box, and is read aloud by the card's author.
- 5. The class then discusses how this strength/interest and goal can help someone to become a physically, mentally, and socially healthy person.
- 6. The student can keep their card as a reminder of their future success.

Assessment:

Students identify the author's purpose in a simple text. They understand the cause of events, and compare them to their lives.
