Lesson #3



Age:
Kindergarten

Objective:

- Students will respond critically to fiction using personal perspective in responding to a work of literature.
- Students will understand the power of language by describing an object through non-verbal communication.

Materials:

The Garden Gathering by Julie Woik

Crayons, Markers, or Colored Pencils

Printed out form attached that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *The Garden Gathering*. After the reading, hand out the form showing Lilly the Lash as an eyelash fairy. Ask the students to think about what their eyelash fairy might look like, and have them draw and color it.

Assessment:

Students demonstrate the ability to respond critically to a literary work of fiction, using their personal perspective by drawing their own eyelash fairy.
