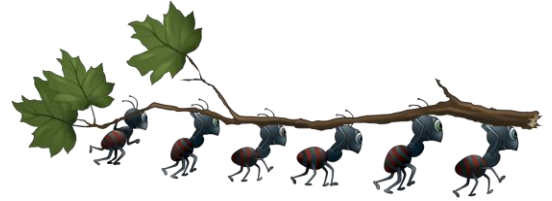


Jungle Jive

Lesson #5



Age:
1st Grade

Objective:

- Students will learn to recognize and determine the basic measurement concept of weight.
- Students will effectively use their knowledge of measures to solve problems.

Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik

Pencils

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *Jungle Jive*, showing everyone the illustrations. Hand out the form that goes with this activity. Have the children compare the images from the *Jungle Jive* book, appearing in each box. Ask them to think carefully about the two items, and then circle the one that they believe is heavier in weight than the other. This is a good exercise for children to recognize differences in measurement.

Assessment:

Students will understand a variety of measurement strategies that will help them effectively recognize and describe the differences found in varying objects.
