## Lesson #2

### Objective:

- Students will learn about the world in spatial terms.
- Students will determine the absolute and relative location of people, places, and things.
- Students will use simple maps to identify and locate places.

### Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik

### Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *Jungle Jive*, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form that correlates with this activity. As a group, discuss how gridlines on a map are used to determine a particular location. Have the children find the items listed, and write the locations of those items by using the numbers and letters on the gridline.

### Assessment:
