Objective:

- Students will understand that word choices can shape ideas, feelings, and actions.
- Students will be able to identify, define, and demonstrate correct usage of adverbs.

Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik

Pencils

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *Jungle Jive*, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form that correlates with this activity. Talk about how important it is to have lively, interesting verbs in sentences; and how adverbs help to make verbs more interesting and easier to understand. Then have them find and circle the adverbs in each sentence.

Assessment:

Students will increase their knowledge of word structure and understand the power of language, and how a word choice can shape a particular feeling in written text. They will understand how adverbs are used, and will include them in their stories!!
