Jungle Jive Lesson #3

Age: 2nd Grade



Objective:

- Students will understand that word choices can shape ideas, feelings, and actions.
- Students will be able to identify, define, and demonstrate correct usage of adverbs.

Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik
Pencils
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Jungle Jive, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form that correlates with this activity. Talk about how important it is to have lively, interesting verbs in sentences; and how adverbs help to make verbs more interesting and easier to understand. Then have them find and circle the adverbs in each sentence.

Assessment:

Students will increase their knowledge of word structure and understand the power of language, and how a word choice can shape a particular feeling in written text. They will understand how adverbs are used, and will include them in their stories!!
