Jungle Jive Lesson #4



Age: 2nd Grade

Objective:

- Students will use writing processes effectively.
- Students will use personal perspective to communicate ideas and information effectively.

Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik
Pencils or Pens
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Jungle Jive, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, discuss the problems that occurred in the town, and how the problems affected both the animals and the environment. Then hand out the form that correlates with this activity. Have the children use their great imagination to create and write a paragraph telling Lilly the Lash what they would have done differently.

Assessment:

Students will use their writing skills to create a paragraph surrounding a central idea. They will utilize their knowledge and experiences to express their opinion and ideas clearly.
