Age: 3rd Grade

Objective:

- Students will write comments and observations that reflect comprehension of content.
- Students will read and organize information to assist in creating a report.

Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik
Pencils
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.
See attached Letter for Parents

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Jungle Jive, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, discuss and review the story briefly. Hand out the form that correlates with this activity. Have the children write a summary about the book, and then their honest opinions regarding the book as a whole. You are welcome to contact the author and send them to her to review. She will be happy to write back to the class!

Assessment:

Students will read in order to construct meaning from the text. They will identify and communicate their personal preferences regarding the content and general feel of the book.
