Jungle Jive Lesson #2



Age: 3rd Grade

Objective:

- Students will use simple strategies such as word structure, context clues, and self-questioning to identify words and construct meaning.
- Students will increase knowledge of vocabulary by reviewing and recalling correct spellings.

Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik
Pencils
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Jungle Jive, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form that correlates with this activity. Have the students find and circle the words found throughout the story.

NOTE: The number in parentheses depicts the amount of times the word can be found in the puzzle.

Assessment:

Students will recognize correct spellings and will increase their knowledge of vocabulary by reviewing and recalling words found throughout the storybook.
