Jungle Jive Lesson #4

Age: 3rd Grade



Objective:

- Students will determine the main idea or essential message and express relevant or supporting details and facts.
- Students will use listening strategies effectively.
- Students will construct meaning from and respond to a work of literature.

Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik
Pencils
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Jungle Jive, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, have the students discuss the story and its message, perhaps rereading some of the important paragraphs. Then hand out the form in which students will provide their own opinion regarding Lilly's lesson from this story.

Assessment:

Students will listen and respond by asking questions and making a contribution to the discussion regarding the storyline. They will recognize the difference between fact and opinion.
