Age: 3rd Grade

Objective:

• Students will use a variety of simple strategies, including word structure, context clues, self-questioning, confirming simple predictions, and retelling to identify words and construct meaning from illustrations and charts.

Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik Pencils Print out form that correlates with this lesson. Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson. See attached *Letter for Parents*

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Jungle Jive, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, have the children do the fun activity Code of the Jungle. Show them how to fill in the blanks by using the chart of items and characters from the book to find the letters needed to break the secret code! Have fun!!!!

Assessment:

Students will create words in the puzzle using the illustrations from the book and the chart that corresponds to the coded question and answer. They will build their vocabulary through this fun exercise.
