

# Jungle Jive

## Lesson #3



**Age:**  
5<sup>th</sup> Grade

### Objective:

- Students understand the power of language.
- Students will organize information using numerical systems.
- Students will be able to create narratives in which events are in a logical order.

### Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik

Pencils

### Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *Jungle Jive*, showing everyone the illustrations. Discuss the meaning of temporal words and phrases, and how they can affect the events of a story. Then have the children number each group 1 thru 3 in the order they happen. Lastly, have them write out three sentences that use words of timing or sequence.

### Assessment:

Students will understand the use of language and how it can affect the timing and sequence of events in a story. They will recognize how to use temporal words and phrases correctly in their own narratives.
