Jungle Jive Lesson #4

Age: 5th Grade



Objective:

- Students will discover one's own family history.
- Students will determine the various geographic locations of their ancestors.

Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik
Pencils
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.
See attached Letter for Parents

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Jungle Jive, showing everyone the illustrations. Since this book takes place in a jungle with lots of trees, let's do a family tree! Hand out the form that correlates to this lesson. Explain what a family tree is. Then have the children fill out the family tree spots as best they can. They can take them home and get help from anyone in their family. Their mother, father, sister, brother, or even an aunt might be able to help them answer these questions. The goal is to find out who makes up their family tree and where these family members came from.

Assessment:

Students will understand how their family history is broken down and connections were made to bring them to today.
