Jungle Jive Lesson #5

Age: 5th Grade



Objective:

- Students will use listening strategies effectively.
- Students will be able to express relevant or supporting details and facts.
- Students will construct meaning from a work of literature.

Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik
Print out one copy of this activity (for the teacher's eyes only)
Two Bells or Buzzers
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.
See attached Letter for Parents

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Jungle Jive, showing everyone the illustrations. You may want to read the story an additional 5-10 times. Once you feel the children are ready, have them play the game. (Directions and the questions/answers are on the activity sheet). Place a bell or buzzer in front of each of the two players at the beginning of each round. Once the teacher/adult has read the question, the player who feels they can answer the question, must ring the bell and say "I GOT IT!" The team with the most points at the end WINS!!!!!

Assessment:

Students will use their listening skills to organize information and produce details and facts regarding the text. Reviewing the text in this manner will provide a fun opportunity for students to discuss the purpose and meaning of the storyline.
