Jungle Jive Lesson #2



Age:

Pre-Kindergarten

Objective:

- Students will listen for characteristic sounds and effectively identify text related words.
- Students will increase their level-appropriate vocabulary.

Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik Colors, Markers, or Color Pencils Print out form that correlates with this lesson. Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson. See attached Letter for Parents

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Jungle Jive, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, recall the characters seen throughout the storybook, being sure to review the type of animal/insect/rodent these characters are portraying. Hand out the form created for this activity. Have the children look over the characters, and sound out the types of animals/insects/rodents they are. Then have them write the first letter of each character on the line provided.

Assessment:

Students will recognize basic images from the story, and will use sound patterns to identify letters and words to describe those images.
