Objective:

- Students will begin to identify simple words and effectively recognize basic patterns of language.

Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik

Crayons, Markers, or Color Pencils

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Jungle Jive, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, discuss how words, both big and small, are used to create stories. Talk about how words, when put together properly, make sentences. Hand out the form for this activity. Have the students repeat the six words found in Lilly's Word Walk, and then have them find and circle them. Perhaps you can have each student say a sentence using one of the words in the activity.

Assessment:

Students will increase their knowledge of language and further develop their vocabulary by recognizing and identifying words from the storybook text.
