Jungle Jive Lesson #4



Age:

Pre-Kindergarten

Objective:

• Students will recognize and understand the common features in a work of literature.

Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik Crayons, Markers, or Color Pencils Print out form that correlates with this lesson. Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson. See attached Letter for Parents

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Jungle Jive, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form showing the pages from the story. Through discussion, recap the story by addressing the questions that assess what happened. Talk to the children about the importance of thinking about their actions and choices before they do something. Explain how the actions they take can affect others or the environment they live in. Show them the value of keeping balance in their life, as well as the world around them.

Assessment:

Students will be able to identify story elements such as setting, plot, character, problem, and resolution.
