Age:
Pre-Kindergarten

## Objective:

- Students will learn about primary colors.
- Students will recognize an object by its observable and measurable properties.


## Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik
Crayons, Markers, or Color Pencils
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson. See attached Letter for Parents

## Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Jungle Jive, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, turn back to the page in which Lilly the Lash is flying over the land displaying a big colorful rainbow. Discuss the different colors found in a rainbow. Then hand out the form for this activity. Have the students color the rainbow. After they color the rainbow, have them name items that match the various colors in the rainbow. Red $=$ Apple. Yellow = Banana.

## Assessment:

Students will learn and recognize the colors of a rainbow. They'll identify the shape of the rainbow, and utilize it as an example to describe objects with similar physical properties.
