Jungle Jive Lesson #8

Behavioral Issue:

Does not respond appropriately to praise or recognition

Objective:

- Students will understand the meaning and value of acknowledging praise and recognition.
- Students will learn to recognize what praise looks like when they see or hear it.
- Students will respond appropriately to praise.

Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik Letter size paper Print out the sheet that correlates with this lesson

Activity:

Read the Jungle Jive book to the child/children who will be participating in this activity. Review how the imbalance in the community made everyone feel uncomfortable. Talk about the importance balance plays in our lives. If we're doing things incorrectly, and someone tells us so, it's best if we think about our actions, and fix things to keep the balance. If we're doing things correctly, and someone tells us so, it's best if we think about our actions, thank them for their praise, realize that we did a good job, and recognize the balance we're bringing to our lives. Let's accept praise if someone is offering it!!!!!

Assessment:

Students will understand the importance of an appropriate reaction when presented with praise. They'll learn to accept praise and recognition, and in turn...maybe even give it!!
