

# The Kacklin' Kitchen

## Lesson #1



### Behavioral Issue:

Makes inappropriate comments to other students

### Objective:

- Students will recognize their language and behavior towards others as inappropriate
- Students will make appropriate comments to others

### Materials:

The Kacklin' Kitchen by Julie Woik

Print out the form that correlates with this lesson

### Activity:

Read The Kacklin' Kitchen with the child or children who are participating in this activity. After the reading, talk about Mookie MaGee's behavior. Discuss how Mookie's behavior and the way he spoke, frightened everyone. Chat about the importance of one's language and behavior when speaking to others, and how certain rules of conduct need to be followed in order to get along with others. Now have the student/s read and discuss each example in this lesson. Have them figure out which ones are appropriate or inappropriate, and what could have been done differently.

### Assessment:

Students will develop appropriate ways to interact with peers. They'll learn to make positive choices when speaking to individuals or groups. They'll learn to express any anger or frustrated feelings to the correct persons in the correct way at the correct time.
