- 4. The teacher asks if anyone can answer the math question on the board. Joey raises his hand, answers the question correctly, and then calls the rest of the class stupid.
- 5. Joey is chosen to be first in line for lunch. He gets up from his desk, walks to the door, and stands straight while the teacher directs the other students. Joey smiles and says hello to Michael and Randy as they get into line behind him.
- 6. The class is on a field trip. Joey has already sat down on the bus. When Carol and Tia sit on the seat in front of him, he leans over and says, "This must be the ugly row!"
- 7. While outside playing before school, Joey tells Diego he's going to hurt him.
- 8. Joey raises his hand to answer a question. The teacher doesn't choose Joey, she choses Latisha. Joey put his hand down, looked kindly at Latisha, and said, "Good job."
- 9. Tina places her books on Joey's desk for a moment while she wipes off her desk. Joey pushes the books off of his desk onto the floor and tells Tina that he hates her.
- 10. Joey calls Gavin a naughty word.
