Objective:

- Students will effectively identify correct sentence structure.
- Students will recognize basic patterns of language.
- Students will use their speaking strategies to ask questions regarding language usage in a text read aloud.

Materials:

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Kacklin' Kitchen, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form in which students will learn about and review what role articles play in the structure of a sentence.

Assessment:

Students will recognize and use their knowledge of articles to effectively communicate when writing or speaking. They will understand the significance of an article and definite article, and how it affects the sentence.
