Objective:

- Students will effectively use their listening strategies for informational purposes.
- Students will recall specific details from a work of literature they have read.

Materials:

The Kacklin' Kitchen by Julie Woik

Pencils

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *The Kacklin' Kitchen*, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form in which students will provide the correct answers from the text provided. This may be a great opportunity to discuss the lesson of RESPECT covered in this story.

Assessment:

Students will identify words and construct meaning from the text. They will increase their comprehension of the storyline by rereading and retelling.
