# Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Kacklin' Kitchen, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form in which students will provide the correct answers from the text provided. This may be a great opportunity to discuss the lesson of RESPECT covered in this story.

#### Assessment:

Students will identify words and construct meaning from the text. They will increase their comprehension of the storyline by rereading and retelling.
