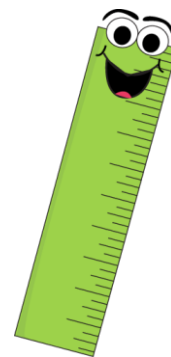


# The Kacklin' Kitchen

**Age:**  
1<sup>st</sup> Grade

### **Objective:**

- Students will recognize and determine basic measurement concepts including length and height.
- Students will effectively use their knowledge of measures to solve problems.

### **Materials:**

The Kacklin' Kitchen by Julie Woik

### **Activity:**

Gather the children in a circle and read *The Kacklin' Kitchen*, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form in which students will compare systems of measure to problem solve.
