Objective:

- Students will use the reading process effectively to identify words from text.
- Students will recognize basic patterns in language.

Materials:

The Kacklin' Kitchen by Julie Woik

Pencils or Pens

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *The Kacklin' Kitchen*, showing everyone the incredible illustrations. After the reading, print the form in which students will verify the meaning of a contraction, and then connect all of the contractions to the correct word groups.

Assessment:

Students will increase their knowledge of word structure and understand the power of language, and how a word choice can shape a particular feeling in written text.
