Objective:

- Students will use listening strategies effectively, and will construct meaning from a work of literature.
- Students will use the writing process to communicate ideas and information.

Materials:

The Kacklin' Kitchen by Julie Woik

Pencils

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read 'The Kacklin' Kitchen, showing everyone the incredible illustrations. After the reading, have the students discuss the story and its message, perhaps rereading and retelling some of the important paragraphs. Then print the form in which students will express their own feelings about bullying and respect.

Assessment:

Students will listen and respond by asking questions and making a contribution to the discussion regarding the storyline. They will recognize the difference between fact and opinion, and understand how the cause of events in the text compare with those in his or her own life.
