The Kacklin' Kitchen Lesson #1



Age: 4th Grade

Objective:

- Students will use simple strategies such as word structure, context clues, and self-questioning to identify words and construct meaning.
- Students will increase knowledge of vocabulary by reviewing and recalling correct spellings.

Materials:

The Kacklin' Kitchen by Julie Woik
Pencils or Pens
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Kacklin' Kitchen, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, have the students define the words found in The Kacklin' Kitchen and then find them in the puzzle. NOTE: The number in parentheses depicts the amount of times the word can be found in the puzzle.

Assessment:

Students will increase knowledge of vocabulary by defining words, reviewing and recalling the correct spellings, and finding them in the word search activity.
