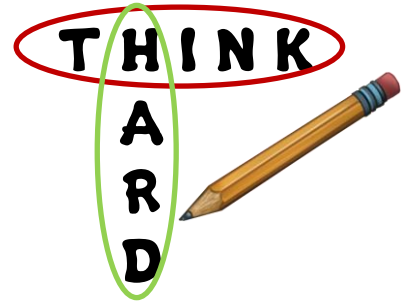


The Kacklin' Kitchen

Lesson #1



Age:
4th Grade

Objective:

- Students will use simple strategies such as word structure, context clues, and self-questioning to identify words and construct meaning.
- Students will increase knowledge of vocabulary by reviewing and recalling correct spellings.

Materials:

The Kacklin' Kitchen by Julie Woik

Pencils or Pens

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *The Kacklin' Kitchen*, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, have the students define the words found in *The Kacklin' Kitchen* and then find them in the puzzle.

NOTE: The number in parentheses depicts the amount of times the word can be found in the puzzle.

Assessment:

Students will increase knowledge of vocabulary by defining words, reviewing and recalling the correct spellings, and finding them in the word search activity.
