Age:
4th Grade

Objective:

- Students will use simple strategies such as word structure, context clues, and self-questioning to identify words and construct meaning.
- Students will clarify understanding by rereading, checking other sources, and class or group discussion.

Materials:

The Kacklin' Kitchen by Julie Woik

Pencils or Pens

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Access to dictionaries (physical copy or computer generated)

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read 'The Kacklin' Kitchen, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, have the students define words found in various sentences throughout the story. After everyone is finished, have a class discussion. Review the words by having the students recite a new sentence using the word.

Assessment:

Students will increase knowledge of vocabulary by defining, understanding, and reviewing challenging words.
