

The Kacklin' Kitchen

Lesson #1



Age:
5th Grade

Objective:

- Students will create a narrative in which the idea, details, and events are in a logical order and are relevant to the storyline.

Materials:

The Kacklin' Kitchen by Julie Woik

Pencils or Pens

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Print and cut the words/phrases from the Words list and put them in a hat or large bowl or some other fun object

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read 'The Kacklin' Kitchen, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, have the students pick out 9 words/phrases from a hat. These are words found in The Kacklin' Kitchen. Hand out the form for this lesson. Have the students write down their 9 words in the spaces provided and have them create and write their own story, somehow incorporating the words they have chosen.

Assessment:

Students will increase their writing ability to communicate ideas and information effectively.
