# The Kacklin' Kitchen Lesson #3



Age: 5<sup>th</sup> Grade

# Objective:

• Students will recognize different techniques used in media messages and their purpose.

#### Materials:

The Kacklin' Kitchen by Julie Woik
Pencils or Pens/Colored Pencils/Markers
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

## Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Kacklin' Kitchen, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form associated with this lesson. Discuss the causes Lilly the Lash books support. Ask the students to think about something they feel is very important to their life and heart. Have them create some sort of symbol to represent their "cause", and have them write a slogan to go with it. At the bottom, ask them express why this cause is important to them.

## Assessment:

Students will understand that a variety of messages can be conveyed through mass media.
