#### Objective:

## Materials:

## Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Kacklin' Kitchen, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form associated with this lesson. Have the students research the different items on the form. The author has listed facts about these items, however, have the students come up with a few facts of their own. Their investigative skills will be the key to this activity!

#### Assessment:

Students will learn to use reference materials, encyclopedias, and digital technology to investigate, read, and organize information to produce details and facts regarding the text.
