Kindergarten

Objective:

- Students will use objects to represent whole numbers from 1 to 20.
- Students will understand that whole numbers can be represented in a variety of equivalent forms.

Materials:

The Kacklin' Kitchen by Julie Woik Colors, Markers, or Pencils Print out form that correlates with this lesson. Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson. See attached Letter for Parents

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Kacklin' Kitchen, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form in which students will solve the problems involving addition of whole numbers.

Assessment:
