Objective:

- Students will use writing processes effectively by practicing correct spellings of SIGHT WORDS.
- Students will increase comprehension of SIGHT WORDS, by reading them aloud.

Materials:

The Kacklin' Kitchen by Julie Woik
Pencils
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.
See attached Letter for Parents

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Kacklin' Kitchen, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form that provides different words used in the book. Ask the students to write out the word on their own, and then read each word aloud.

Assessment:

Students increase their comprehension of sight words by writing and rereading them aloud. They will identify word structure and increase their developmental-level vocabulary.
