### Objective:

### Materials:

### Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *The Kacklin' Kitchen*, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form in which students will identify the characters in the story. Rereading and reviewing may be necessary to help students recall all of the characters from the storybook. This will provide an opportunity to discuss the story plot, and the importance of giving and receiving RESPECT!
