Age:

Pre-Kindergarten

Objective:

• Students will analyze patterns related to physical characteristics such as shapes and colors to identify items identical to one another.

Materials:

The Kacklin' Kitchen by Julie Woik Colors, Markers, or Color Pencils Print out form that correlates with this lesson. Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson. See attached Letter for Parents

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Kacklin' Kitchen, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form in which students will circle the item that is the same in each row. Afterwards discuss the lesson of respect from the book. Remind and encourage the students to treat one another as they want to be treated!

Assessment:

Students will observe and recognize a variety of schemes and patterns to successfully interpret similarities and differences.
